Vaccines are safe and effective.
Get vaccinated as soon as you can!





#### THE BENEFITS OF VACCINATION



It is a simple, safe and very effective way to protect people from harmful diseases and their consequences.



We protect ourselves so that if we come in contact with the virus, we will not get seriously sick, but only have mild symptoms.



The more people get vaccinated, the more is reduced the risk of spreading pandemic to those around us.



By reducing the number of people who get sick, we are helping doctors to care more effectively for those infected with the virus.

#### **KEEP COMPLYING WITH PROTECTION MEASURES**

Like all vaccines, the Covid-19 vaccines do not provide 100% protection. It is important that after you have been vaccinated to continue to comply with all protective measures such as wearing a mask, social distancing and frequent hand washing.

#### SIDE EFFECTS OF VACCINATION

The side effects that may occur are mild and temporary, such as pain in the arm at the injection site, fever, nausea, muscle pain and headache. All these symptoms fade quickly.

It is very rare for a severe allergic reaction to the vaccine to occur. If it does so, it usually occurs within minutes and the staff administering the vaccine are trained to deal with any allergic reactions immediately.





### WHERE CAN I GET VACCINATED

To schedule your vaccination you need to visit the website: https://emvolio.gov.gr

If you don't have access to the internet, you can contact the KEP in your area.

If you are staying in a shelter, asylum seekers' accommodation center or any other facility, contact the person in charge of the facility and/or the organisation providing medical care services within the facility.

## HOW CAN I GET THE VACCINATION CERTIFICATE

Once the vaccination is completed (1 or 2 doses depending on the vaccine) you can get the EU Digital COVID Certificate.

To get the digital certificate you will need to visit the website:

https://eudcc.gov.gr/start

You will also need to have:

- Your Taxisnet username & password
- Your AMKA or PAAYPA number

If you can't issue the certificate digitally, you may book an appointment at myKEPlive to be served via videoconference or visit the KEP in your area.

If you do not have an AMKA or PAAYPA number, you can issue a temporary AMKA, to be used exclusively for the vaccination and the issue of the certificate, on the website:

https://emvolio.gov.gr/pamka

It is important to get vaccinated soon and not to wait.

By doing so, we build immunity in our communities and we will be able to return to our normal life sooner.
